TEAM ABSOLUTES

- 1. **Proper Uniform Policy** (Includes practices and games)
 - a. Players will be expected to wear the same jersey, pants, belts and hats for both practices and games.
 - b. If sleeves and/or layers are required/necessary due to weather, players must wear black sleeves and layers must be Maize South baseball hoodies, jackets, pullovers etc.
 - c. Players are required to wear Maize South hats daily to practices and games.
 - i. Strike 1: Player owes team and coaches apology and has required consequence completed at practice with coaches.
 - ii. Strike 2: Player's practice is over and they must go home after apologizing to the team and coaches.
